

UNT Dallas is dedicated to helping students and families in the pursuit of their educational goals. According to the passing of Senate Bill 1528 (SB 1528, effective September 1, 2006), Texas law allows students that are neither US citizens nor permanent residents to be classified as a Texas resident for admissions and financial aid purposes.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Must have graduated from a Texas high school or received the equivalent of a high school diploma (e.g. GED) in the state of Texas;
- 2. Must have resided in the state of Texas for the three years immediately preceding graduation from high school or the receipt of the GED certificate;
- 3. Must have resided or will have resided in Texas for the 12 months prior to enrollment at University of North Texas at Dallas; and
- 4. Must provide the attached *notarized* affidavit* stating that:

"I will file an application to become a permanent resident of the U.S. at the earliest opportunity I am eligible to do so."

NEXT STEPS:

- 1. Complete and submit an UNT Dallas application for admission.
- 2. Submit application fee or fee waiver.
- 3. Submit original high school transcript and SAT or ACT scores.
- 4. Complete and submit attached notarized affidavit as described above to UNT Dallas Office of Admissions via mail or in-person delivery.
